The **Prineville Transportation System Plan (TSP)** is a plan to quide the City's future transportation

is a plan to guide the City's future transportation system. It is a City document that will recommend programs, policies, and physical improvements to all aspects of the transportation system to address current and future transportation needs.

What will the TSP accomplish?

- Improves connections and safety for all people traveling in the City, including those who drive, walk, bike, use a wheelchair or cane, and deliver freight.
- Addresses congestion and safety for all roadway users along U.S. 26 / 3rd Street.
- Sets a 20-year plan for improving transportation to support Prineville's growing population.

What is happening so far?

- Developing draft solutions to address mobility and safety at the "West Y" and O'Neil Hwy / OR 126 intersections.
- Developing draft solutions to address congestion and expand mobility for all travelers on 3rd Street.
- Developing strategies to improve safety at high-crash intersections.
- Proposing expansions of street networks that support people walking, hauling freight, and riding bicycles.
- Conducting traffic analysis to determine how draft solutions might impact future congestion.
